

CARE, MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING - VINYL

Following these care instructions will help extend the lifespan of your vinyl flooring.

Preventative Care

- *During warmer months (spring, summer, fall): Use an air conditioner or dehumidifier as needed.*
- *During winter: Run a central humidifier to prevent shrinkage caused by low humidity.*

Preventing Scratches & Blemishes

- *Regularly remove dirt, dust, grit, and salt to protect the wear layer.*
- *Use area rugs and mats at entrances and high-traffic areas to reduce wear. Clean them frequently to prevent trapped debris.*
- *Keep sharp objects like high heels and cleats off the floor to avoid permanent damage.*
- *Attach felt pads or floor protectors to furniture legs and lift rather than drag furniture when moving it.*
- *When vacuuming, avoid using plastic or metal attachments that may scratch the surface.*
- *Prevent prolonged contact with rubber items (e.g., latex, bicycle wheels), as they may cause staining due to chemical reactions.*

Water & Spill Management

- *Immediately wipe and dry any spills, avoiding excess moisture in plank seams.*
- *DO NOT use household cleaners such as oils, soaps, waxes, Pine-Sol, vinegar, or other harsh agents, as they can damage the finish and void the warranty.*
- *Avoid steam cleaners, as they can harm vinyl flooring.*

Sunlight & Discoloration

- *Long-term exposure to direct sunlight may cause natural fading or discoloration.*
- *Use light-filtering window treatments like blinds or drapes to reduce sun damage.*

By following these guidelines, you can keep your vinyl flooring in excellent condition for years to come.
